## One hit wonders

Now here was a fun match day that had some unusual features that was interesting, educational and entertaining. This August day was nice, not too hot and with a turnout of 11 shooters made for a great day. We started the day with a 28 pistol, 5 doughboy or 5 pcc and 6 shotgun at the corral using the mounted cowboy targets for pistol. The center cowboy was dressed in white and Commando Jarrett was in whites so this stage could of been called "Don't shoot Bruce" as the center target was not engaged. The targets were engaged in a double tap double tap double tap single. Triple F luckily found us a pile of red ants where we needed to stand so no one stood around at the start very long. Wautaga Kid thought they would make great targets!

Moving over to the fort for an exciting 42 round all pistol stage with no double taps and the shooter only moving one time made for a great stage. This stage featured all 8" swinger targets set at 10 and 15 yards. This stage called for speed and precision which are some of Goatneck's favorite things. Shooter began at Texas surrender then on the first plate rack Nevada swept the left side, right side, then across, moved to the other identical plate rack and shot the same sweeps. All the competitors enjoyed this stage with Greased Light'nin and Hoodoo Brown shooting traditional and burning it up. Evil Roy thought this would be a great state level stage

Moving to Brazos Point for a 28 pistol, 5 doughboy/7pcc and 5 shotgun.

Using the dueling trees and static plates brought a big smile to Wicked Felina 'cause she likes working over the dueling trees! This stage featured 7 pcc at about 22 yards while the doughboy was about 65 yards. Speaking of doughboy this class continues in popularity and is a favorite of Billy Bob who said he would enjoy the category at state if it were offered. Good news is it will be a side match at the state match along with 10 more sides that are going to be a large time for all that like to shoot.

We stayed under BP for the fourth stage and Shot a 28 pistol 5DB/10pcc This was a fast moving stage that Capt Sam Evans enjoyed and utilized different sweeps along with the small swingers on the hostage targets. Getting the last stage completed a needed break was taken for a really nice lunch featuring a deluxe ham sandwich with all the extras. Thanks Sid! President Shady McLarry read the results for everyone, great conversation and back to the range where things were kicked off with a long range pistol match, auto set 6" targets placed at 46 and 66 yards. The first time thru was offhand 3 shots per target, several hit it once. The one hit wonders. Next time thru shooting on the bench rested resulted in several more one hit wonders, a couple with 2 hits and the king of the hill Evil Roy with 3 hits. Pulling out the bolt guns it was time for BAMB sniper and combat. Sniper was 10 shots Nevada sweep out to about 110 yards resting on bench, bolt open at beep close bolt and engage. One reload on the clock. The combat match was shot from 2 locations and could be shot standing, setting, prone, slinged etc. All 8 shooters chose offhand due to the speed of movement. Targets ranged to about 75 yards. Top 5 in sniper 5 Hoodoo 4 Evil Roy 3 Goatneck 2 Billy Bob 1 Dusty combat 5 Bruce 4 Hoodoo 3 Evil Roy 2 Dusty 1 Goatneck. A Suomi in 9mm was

passed around and Triple F brought out a red dot sighted Taurus raging bull in 44 special that was a shooter. A large time was had!

Texas State Wild Bunch Championship Skirmish at Mills Creek Oct 19, 20, 21 this match will feature 10 great stages. 5 Saturday, 5 Sunday with a total of 11 extremely entertaining and well thought out side events. Friday will host several great side matches with the balance on Saturday. Featuring the Texas state BAMB championship which consists of a 10 round sniper stage and a 15 round combat stage. In addition to BAMB we have Doughboy which is a wild bunch type stage but using the bolt action rifle at targets placed under 80 yards.

GAMM: Garand Action Military Match. What does a Garand have to do with WB? Not much but it's going to be lots of fun! 8 rounds

Fastest long range pistol: accuracy and speed. Boom Boom boardwalk: a pleasant stroll along the beautiful boardwalk with shotgun in hand using it on multiple targets. 1/2 box of shells at least! Last man standing: good old fashioned fun dueling against a random gunfighter. Duck you Sucker: the birds are flying fast all incoming, load 6 and repeat. Fastest pistol: shoot the static then the dueling tree, Repeat Fastest long range pistol caliber rifle: big ole easy target and it's out around 60 yards. Pour the lead on it.

The Educated Shootist: This is the sass scholarship fundraiser. Targets out to 55 yards all targets are 6" costs \$10 plus mulligans can be bought. Winner gets universal gift cards of \$40 and the biggest bragging rights in existence, based on 10 shooters.

The prize drawing table is fattening up really well. Great looking usable trophies. Time to sign up!

New competitors are always welcome. We just ask that you read the rule book. Don't worry about correct gear. Any pump shotgun, any sass legal pistol caliber rifle and ANY 1911 gets you shooting open class to try this great sport. Use your cowboy holster and stage magazines. Tips: Know where all your guns shoot. You will need those things called sights. Load clean quality in spec ammo. Use all your magazines loaded to 7 to check for problems with them. If one has a problem repair or replace. It won't heal on its own. Most 1911 problems are bad ammo or bad magazines or both.

## BATTLE OF ADOBE WALLS

In 1874, the word on the High Plains was that the savage Indians were coming after the buffalo hunters for venturing into the Texas Panhandle to hunt the buffalo. It was true that the hunters were doing just that. As a result, the Indians were attacking the secluded buffalo hunting camps. This was one reason for several hunting groups to come into the Adobe Walls post. They would report that they had been attacked, usually resulting in one or two of their group being killed by the savages. They felt safer at Adobe Walls. Word had come to Myers, Rath, and Hanrahan of the news about the upcoming attack on

the post by the Indians. They did not tell the buffalo hunters exactly what was fixin to happen. They didn't want the men to leave, because the post would be left unprotected and, subsequently destroyed. Interestingly enough, Myers and Rath did leave; they took the buffalo hides on to Dodge City. Hanrahan chose to remain behind and protect his whiskey supply. Rath and Myers left people in charge of their stores.

Hanrahan, and perhaps Billy Dixon, knew when the Indian attack was supposed to happen. At the post were 28 men, and just one woman. They would defend against 700 to 1000 savages. Hanrahan knew that the attack would occur between 4:00 AM and 6:00 AM. He did not want to have the men surprised; in order to make sure that they were awake, Hanrahan arranged for a pistol shot at 2:00 AM. He explained this as the store tent's ridge pole breaking. Thus the hunters were awake, and chose to drink at the bar for a while. They were still awake when the Indians attacked. The savages immediately killed, scalped, and mutilated the Shadler brothers; they were camped out in their wagon. Since the other hunters were not surprised, but wide awake, the Indians suffered many casualties amongst their killed and wounded. This included a Negro bugler who would sound "charge". Of course, this enabled the hunters to know when the next horse and rider sweep was coming.

As the Indians were being soundly slaughtered, they reconnoitered to reconsider the situation for their plan of attack. They were on a bluff hill 1538 yards away (7/8 mile) from Adobe Walls. Buffalo hunter Billy Dixon had at his disposal a friend's .50-90 Sharps buffalo gun; a 500 yard shot was the usual accomplishment with that weapon.

On the bluff were the Comanche Chief Quanah and many braves. Amongst them was their so-called medicine man, whom history recollects as Isatai'i. The new young medicine man guaranteed Quanah that he had all the necessary dreams and good medicine to accurately assure his acquaintances that they were in no danger of being shot by occupants of Adobe Walls from this distance of 1538 yards. No sooner had Isatai'i mentioned this, then a shot fired from Billy Dixon struck and killed the warrior mounted on the horse betwixt him and Quanah. Thus ended the promising shaman career of Isatai'i, who was saddled with that unfortunate name. There is some question as to the exact translation, whether it means the behind or feces of a coyote.

Due to this unbelievable rifle shot, the Indians were demoralized (though none more so than Isatai'i). They decided to give up the fight. This was a demoralizing defeat, considering the overwhelming numbers of the Indians. During the month following the battle, the buffalo hunters gradually left the post and took their hides to Dodge City. Hundreds of hides were lost south of the Canadian River as they were abandoned earlier when the hunters scrambled to the post. The Indians destroyed the post and there were large financial losses for Myers, Rath, and Hanrahan. However, the ultimate result was that the Red River Indian War soon followed; this ended the dominance of the savages on the Plains and opened up all of Texas to the buffalo hunters and settlers as well.
