FROM THE CVV PRESIDENT

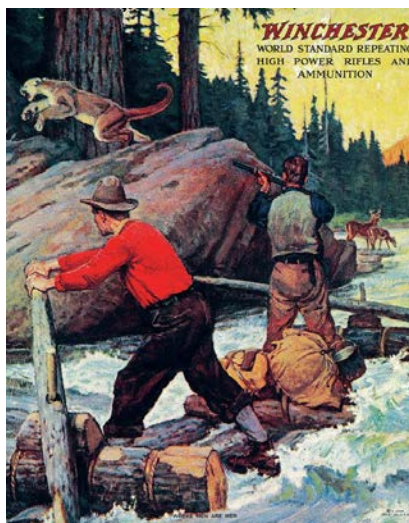

May Match

A great day greeted the group of 12 wild bunch competitors for the May match. Do to the slightly warmer weather jackets were not needed this day. We kept to the shade of Brazos Point and the pecan tree. First stage under BP was a fast 21 pistol along with 5 shotgun to get the ball rolling.

Moving over to the school house area a rare stand and deliver stage was shot under a welcomed shade of the pecan tree. This stage consisted of 6 shotgun including 3 flipped birds, 14 pistol rounds and 8 PCR (pistol caliber rifle) or if dough boy 5 BAMB rifle. This was a well-received stage that everyone had fun with. Back to Brazos Point the silver Sam sweep featured 3 targets with a double tap on 1 and 2 single on 3, 2 and 1. Run to the other end repeat and then sweep 7 targets. Shotgun on 4 knock downs. 7 + 1 Rifle with the 1 being loaded on the clock.

Stage 4 "From Here to Eternity", this was a pistol fight to get to your rifle to finish the fight. Starting at the shade tree by the school house leaning against the bar pistol was shot in banks of 7 "big and small we shot-em all!" Fighting across the school house spilling into Brazos Point and continuing to the far end where

Rifle was retrieved and the last shots were fired. 42 pistol & PCR or 5 BAMB.

Something new for this month was a class for all the American adventurers that crossed the border to join Pancho or others "Rebeldes Gringo." This was shot under open class and instead of using a BAMB rifle for dough boy a rifle caliber lever action rifle is used. 30wcf, 38-55, 45-70, 45-90, 40-65, 40-60 etc. think Winchester 76, 86, 94, 95 yes you can shoot your 95, Marlins are welcome too. Lots of fun! Lead bullets only!

Please note that all competitors must shoot mild shotgun shells. Remember just because shells at Walmart are cheap does not mean they are mild. Lead only 7 1/2 or 8 is great. Shoulders will thanked, targets will fall just as well, speed will increase and the targets will live a longer, happier and more useful life.

Skirmish at Mills Creek, The Texas State Wild Bunch Championship is fast approaching and plans are already being made. This promises to be a great match with a 3 day schedule of shooting fun.

FORT BELKNAP

The line of military forts established on the edge of the frontier to protect the settlements from the raiding, marauding, thieving Indians stretched across Texas. Their purpose included not only protecting the settlers, but also providing some protection for people traveling on to the western United States. Fort Belknap, near the northern edge of this line of forts, played a very important role on the frontier of North West Texas.

Fort Belknap is located west of present day Jacksboro, TX and not far from present day Graham, TX. The general area had brave settlers as early as the 1850s, but this was a very dangerous place to be at that time. The area proved to be dangerous for the next 20 years. In the 1850s, Fort Belknap was sort of the dividing line between the so called "settlements" and the unguarded frontier. Actually, the whole region between Weatherford and Fort Belknap was in a relatively unguarded state. West of the fort was considered the most dangerous place to be.

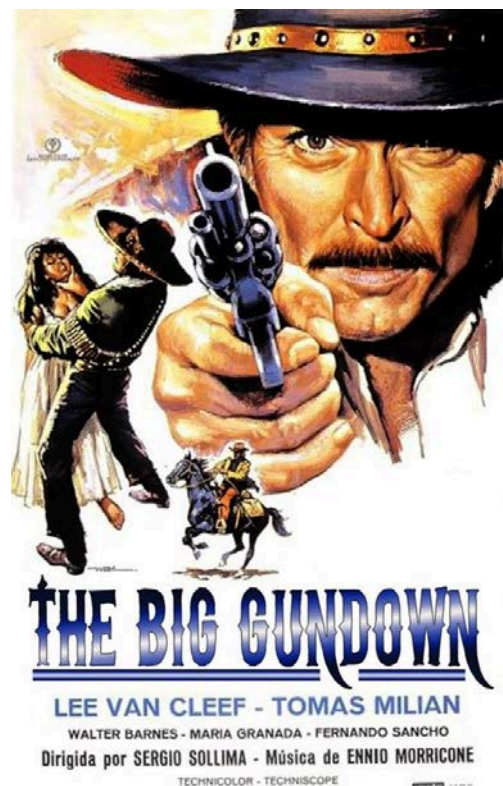
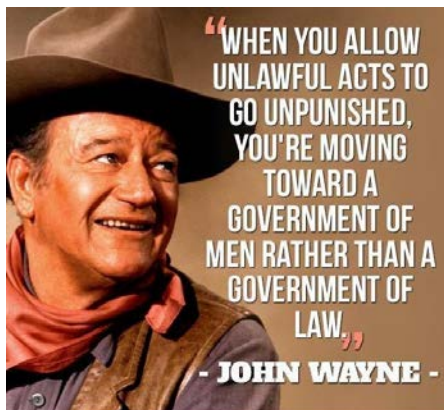
The fort was established by Gen. Wm. G. Belknap in June of 1851, overlooking the Salt Fork of the Brazos River, ten miles north of its confluence with the Clear Fork of the same river. However, in November of 1851, due to dry wells caused by limited water supply, the fort was moved two miles south. Here, there were good springs for adequate water. A successful well was eventually dug. From Fort Belknap, the "roads" branched out to Fort Worth, Dallas, and San Antonio. To the west, the "road" connected to Camp Cooper, Fort Phantom Hill (north of present day Abilene), and on to Fort Chadbourn southwest of present day Abilene. In 1858, the Butterfield Mail Company used Fort Belknap as a depot for the change over from using horses to using mules to pull their coaches. This was based on the belief that the Comanche and Kiowa Indians disliked mules so much that they would never ride one, and would therefore not try to steal them. The same Indians did constantly steal horses wherever and whenever possible.

As was the case with most all of the frontier forts, Fort Belknap was abandoned during the War of Northern Aggression. The troops were moved to Camp Cooper in February of 1859. The town of Fort Belknap struggled through the next several years. However, in 1867, Col. Samuel Sturgis was ordered to re-establish the fort. Col. Sturgis hated the area; he actively campaigned to abandon

the fort. He added salt to water samples from the well and the river, and then claimed the area water supply was too salty to drink. He exaggerated that there were 5000 Indians in the area that could cut off their ability to safely get to an adequate water supply. Regardless of his efforts, the post was ordered to reopen as a permanent fort.

Not giving up, Col. Sturgis located a new place for a fort 35 miles to the south west on the Clear Fork of the Brazos River. The new fort became Fort Griffin. As a result, Fort Belknap was officially abandoned and closed as a fort in the fall of 1867. The stones and useable timbers of the buildings were scavenged by the local people of the town of Belknap, leaving only the magazine and part of the corn house. Thus was the end to one of the most colorful forts of the Texas frontier era. Much of the fort was restored in 1935, and with it a museum; it is a rather nice place to visit today.
