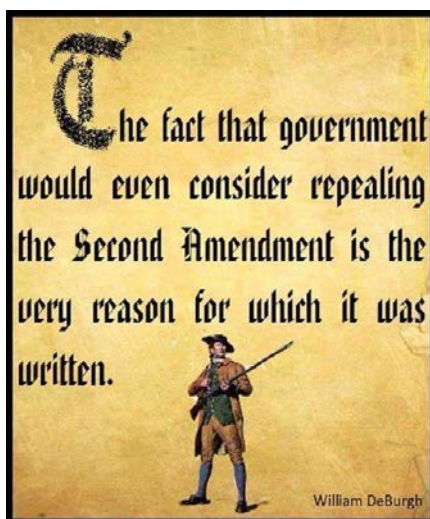

## DOC HOLLIDAY KILLS HIS SECOND MAN

The last time we shared here about Doc Holliday, he had faced legal problems in Dallas stemming from a gambling arrest. His previous dental partner, Dr. Seegar, paid for his successful defense, then asked him to leave Dallas. Seegar's reputation was being harmed by Holliday's drinkin', gamblin' and getting arrested. Doc however, stayed and tried to open another office; however; his worsening bloody cough kept patients away. The Medical Doctor confirmed his worst fears, that he indeed had consumption. This was the same condition that caused his mother's death. Doc Holiday was 23 years old. The doctor advised him to go to Colorado, in hopes the climate might help him live longer. Doc went west—but, instead of Colorado, wound up at Ft. Griffin, TX in 1875.

Ft. Griffin was one of the two main supply locations for the ongoing buffalo slaughter in West Texas. Most all of the buffalo hides and meat went through Ft. Griffin before the wagons ultimately took them to Ft. Worth. From there, the hides went on to their final destination in the Northeast. Ft. Griffin was "wide open" with all of the gamblin', drinkin', whiskey, and whores that a person could desire. This was a dangerous wicked town, with no real law what so ever.

Every now and then, a lawman would come in, make some arrests, collect a few fines, jail two or three whores and drunks—just to make a show of being the "law". Doc Holliday got caught up in one of those raids and was arrested for something.

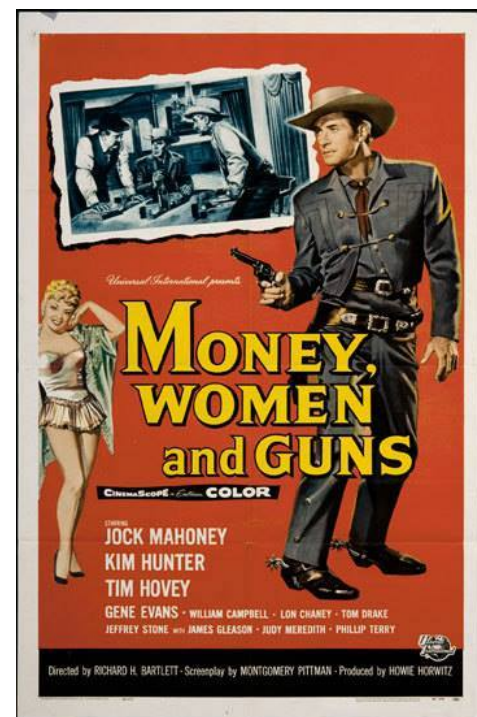
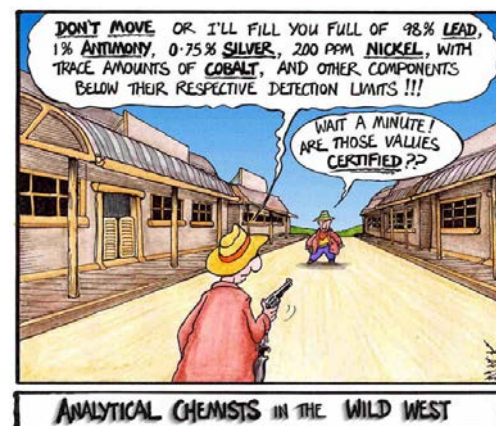
Rather than chance being tried and going to jail, he left town and headed elsewhere. Doc wandered for a while, spending time at Ft. Concho (present day San Angelo), and on to Santone (San Antonio). At Eagle Pass on the border, he even practiced dentistry for a while. Most of that work was extracting teeth for the Mexicans from Piedras Negras. But then he headed north again. He meant to go to Dallas, but stopped off for another interesting stay at Ft. Griffin.

Holliday's friend, saloon owner Johnny Shaughnessy gave Doc a room for the night, as well as a couple of good drinks of whiskey. The room was actually one of the rooms where the prostitutes met with their customers. During his rest, a large black soldier on leave from the military fort up on the hill, burst into the room. He supposedly chose the wrong room whilst looking for a "lady" of the evening. Holliday informed the soldier of the mistake, and asked him to leave. Instead of leaving, the soldier advanced upon Holliday; Doc shot him with his Colt pistol, killing him right there. Mr. Shaughnessy told Holliday that while the lawless community would not particularly care about this one way or another, the military up at the fort would make a real big deal out of one of their soldiers being killed by a civilian in town. He told Doc to get out of town quick.

Despite the circumstances of a possible self defense shooting, Doc Holliday knew he must leave Ft. Griffin. He had now killed his second person. The first had been a teen age freedman back home; now there was this Buffalo Soldier out west. Doc did not think of himself as a "killer", but it had happened none the less. He had to continue on somewhere or else the military would be after him for sure. So in 1876, Doc Holliday heads for St Louis.

In the next issue we will see how he makes it to Denver and beyond.
